- Describe principles of implant hygiene and maintenance relevant to long-term implant health
- Perform guided implant placement procedures using contemporary surgical guides
- Practice implant impression techniques, including analog and digital workflows
- Apply aseptic protocols appropriate for implant surgical procedures
- Refine advanced suturing techniques for soft tissue management in implant dentistry
